Melfort Kinsmen Club – North Park

On behalf of the Melfort Kinsmen & Kinette Club, Mr. Trevis McConaghy appeared before Council to present their proposal for a park in the north end – "North Park", which incorporates a natural, agricultural theme, as indicated in the submitted proposal, and fits into the Play Melfort brand. The Kinsmen & Kinettes request that the City rezone a 180' parcel (appx. 4.5 lots) on the 200 block of Babington Avenue East from R2 Residential to MR - Municipal Reserve, for the purpose of a Kinsmen Park. And further, that the City provide curbing along the property from Cairns Avenue to Babington Avenue. Water is not required at this time. The Kinsmen would like to complete the landscaping and add components as funds are raised and the club sees fit. Council members questioned whether the Kinsmen would be willing to be involved in the Spruce Haven park development, to which Mr. McConaghy replied that they are always interested in working with parks, but Spruce Haven has not been a focus of the club. With respect to the Stovel Park, the Kinsmen have money allocated to pour a concrete pad for shufflecurling/basketball, but have not yet met with the Elks to discuss their involvement. On behalf of Council, Mayor Lang thanked the Kinsmen & Kinettes for the tremendous work they do in the community. The request was referred to the Community Services Committee, for a response back to the Kinsmen/Kinettes by February/March of 2016.
