# 16-10 AUTHORIZE REPORT – REGENT ASPHALT PAVEMENT LIMP:

JungWHEREAS, Section 20(4) of The Local Improvements Act, 1993, permits the SaskatchewanGeorgeMunicipal Board to allow a municipality to fix a lower rate for a work than the rate fixed in the<br/>Uniform Rate Bylaw, where unusual conditions exist;

AND WHEREAS, the property owners on Regent Street, 200 block, were offered and accepted a full depth pavement local improvement program in 2012, at a rate of \$425.00 per front metre, in accordance with Uniform Rate Bylaw 2012-11, which was subsequently approved by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board;

AND WHEREAS, water quality issues forced the City to delay the project until a water main replacement was undertaken in 2015 to resolve those issues;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Director of Works & Utilities prepare a report in accordance with Section 6 of *The Local Improvements Act, 1993,* with respect to the local improvement listed below, fixing a rate of \$425.00 per front metre, which is lower than the full depth pavement rate of \$491.00 contained in the 2015-01 Uniform Rate Bylaw, due to the unusual conditions that exist in carrying out this work:
